- Participates in evaluation efforts.

The Community Dental Health Worker has the following qualifications and skills:

Education and/or Experience:

High school diploma or general education degree (GED); or one to three months related experience and/or training; or equivalent combination of education and experience.

Skills and Abilities:

- Sensitivity to the needs and situations of a multi-cultural, low-income population and a desire to work with this population.

- Excellent people (communication) skills.
- Bi-lingual (Spanish and English).
- Computer software skills including Microsoft Office including Word and Outlook.
