What you will do at AMC:

We are in the midst of the biggest public health crisis of our lives where every aspect of the way we live is affected. Alliance Medical Center has been at the forefront of the Covid-19 response in Sonoma County. The Temporary Registered Nurse (RN) Supervisors' will be part of an extraordinary and skilled Covid-19 testing Team, administering and overseeing the administration of the vaccinations. Reporting to the Medical Director, the Temporary Registered Nurse Supervisors' are responsible for the day to day operations and oversight of Alliance Medical Center's (AMC's) Covid-19 Vaccine Clinics at the assigned clinic site in either Healdsburg or Windsor. The responsibilities include vaccine management, supervision of all clinical staff, and triage.

The *TEMPORARY* Registered Nurse Supervisors' Alliance Medical Center must have the following qualifications and skills:

- Registered Nurse license in State of California, required;
- Candidates must have outpatient, residential or inpatient clinical supervising experience;
- Bilingual in English and Spanish highly preferred but not required; must have good oral and written English proficiency;
- Ability to work effectively with teams while performing independently on quality and timely task completion;
- Must demonstrate empathy and respect for vulnerable populations, interest in working collaboratively and capability to follow-through with assigned tasks.

Employment Status: These positions are W-2, non-exempt hourly roles and are temporary to provide additional support for AMC. Incumbents will not receive employee benefits. These positions are of limited duration and temporary in nature, assignments are *full-time up to 6 months with potential to extend with notice and mutual agreement.*
