- Provides preventative dental services such as cleaning, fluoride application, sealants, and patient education
- Provides restorative dentistry and education within the scope of the practice, such as fillings, crowns, dentures, partials as well as maintenance and treatment of supporting structures
- Evaluates and utilizes the appropriate anesthetic, analgesics and sedation to insure patient comfort.
- Evaluates and prescribes appropriate medications to control pain and infections.
